REFUNDABLE OPTIONS (Route 1)

OPTION A

Refundable with Stage Payments

Upfront Fee:	£1,000 payable on the day of enrolment, followed by 8 monthly instalments of £250 (totalling £3,000).
Franchise Term:	Two years from the date you qualify (i.e. upon passing the Part 3 exam)
Trainee Licence:	Precedes your main contract and allows you to start work sooner at a franchise fee of £125 per week.
Weekly Franchise Fee:	£99.61 per week (including VAT) for the two-year term. This structure allows for a partial course fee refund of £2,640 by the end of year two.
Renewal Terms:	You have the automatic right to renew upon request, ensuring continuity in your role with us.
Ideal For:	Those who prefer to spread training costs while still receiving the majority of the course fee back by the end of year two.

OPTION B

Refundable with Subsidy

Upfront Fee:	Discounted rate of £2,640 (normally £3,000), payable in full on the day of enrolment.
Franchise Term:	Two years from the date you qualify (i.e., upon passing the Part 3 exam).
Trainee Licence:	Precedes your main contract and allows you to start work sooner at a franchise fee of £125 per week.
Weekly Franchise Fee:	£99.61 per week (including VAT) for the two-year term. This provides a full refund of the £2,640 course fee by the end of year two.
Renewal Terms:	You have the automatic right to renew upon request, providing long-term job security.
Ideal For:	Those seeking a shorter contract term, full course fee refund, and an upfront payment discount of £260 . Frequently regarded as our best-value option.

NON REFUNDABLE OPTIONS (Route 2)

OPTION C

Subsidised Plan

Upfront Fee:	£1,780 payable in full on the day of enrolment. Alternatively, if eligible for Klarna, you can spread the cost over three monthly payments of £593.33 .
Franchise Term:	Three years from the date you qualify (i.e., upon passing the Part 3 exam).
Trainee Licence:	Precedes your main contract and allows you to start work sooner at a franchise fee of £125 per week.
Weekly Franchise Fee:	£125 per week (including VAT) for the full three-year term.
Renewal Terms:	You have the automatic right to renew upon request, providing long-term security in your position with us.
Ideal For:	Those looking to reduce their initial investment while benefiting from the structure and experience offered by the trainee licence.

OPTION D

Flexible Plan

Upfront Fee:	£3,300 payable in full on the day of enrolment.
Franchise Term:	Three years from the date you qualify (i.e., upon passing the Part 3 exam).
Trainee Licence:	A trainee licence is not required, but it remains available as an option if you choose to pursue it.
Weekly Franchise Fee:	£125 per week (including VAT) for the duration of the three-year term.
Renewal Terms:	You have the automatic right to renew upon request, ensuring continuity in your position with us.
Ideal For:	Those who prefer not to take the trainee licence route and want a straightforward, post-qualification path.
